**From the Pastor: Forgiving Injuries—a spiritual work of mercy:** Jesus told His disciples that they must forgive those who wronged them. The Lord's Prayer contains a petition where we ask God to forgive us to the same extent that we forgive others. Forgiveness entails not seeking revenge in this life or seeking someone's eternal damnation. It also involves letting grudges go. Grudges lead to anger and no one makes rational decisions when angry. Remember that forgiving and forgetting are two different things. Our Lord did not command us to forget since He does not require us to do the impossible. He did command us to forgive; that is possible especially when we ask God for His grace.
