From the Pastor: On Friday, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of the birth of St. John the Baptist. You will recall that Saint John the Baptist was the child of Elizabeth, the kinswoman of the Blessed Mother. This makes John a cousin of Jesus. This day has also been important in the civil calendar. The birth of St. John the Baptist is considered one of the English quarter days—the days that the sessions of the courts began and lease payments were due. The June quarter day is known as Midsummer Day. William Shakespeare wrote a play about the marriage of the Duke of Athens and the Amazon Queen, among other things. It is known as: "A Midsummer Night's Dream".
