From the Pastor: A sacramental is an object given to us by the Church which confers certain graces upon the one who uses it. Examples include rosaries, chaplets, medals and holy water. Before 1964, the blessing of many sacramentals was reserved to the religious order associated with the object. The blessing of rosaries was reserved to Dominicans and the blessing of scapulars was reserved to Carmelites and the blessing St. Ignatius water (consumed for restoration of health) was reserved to the Jesuits. One of the benefits of being assigned to Conewago is that my predecessors never threw anything away. There is a paper tacked up in one of the sacristy cabinets entitled *Modus Benedecendi Aquam S. Ignatii Confessoris*. The paper is beginning to disintegrate. It has probably been hanging there since the Jesuits left in 1901 and was probably not used since then as this blessing was reserved to the Jesuits until 1964.

July 31 is the feast of St. Ignatius, founder of the Jesuits. I will bless St. Ignatius water today. It will be available in the parish office. Please bring your own bottle.

Next Sunday we will have a second collection for the missions. Fr. Mukaka Mennas Vincent, a Comboni Missionary, will preach at all Masses next weekend. Father is a native of Malawi and currently is in charge of the Comboni Postulantcy where he teaches philosophy and cares for a newly established parish with eight out-stations.
