From the Pastor: Thank you for your prayers for me during my recovery. It appears that all is going well with the healing process though I do still tire easily and will keep a light schedule after dark for a few weeks. I would also like to thank Frs. McNeil, Gotwalt and Mitzel who provided coverage.

On Tuesday, we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints remembering all those souls who are in Heaven. These include the canonized

saints as well as those we do not know of such as members of our family and our friends who have preceded us in death and have entered Heaven.

On Wednesday, we remember those who have died and are now in Purgatory. Remember that the Souls in Purgatory will eventually be in Heaven. They are not sad and we should not be sad; but, we must remember that they cannot help themselves: that is something that only the living can do for them; so, we pray for them and have Masses offered for them and offer up our suffering for them so that they might enter Heaven sooner.

From November 1 through November 8, the Church offers a plenary indulgence, once a day, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory. In order to gain this, we must visit a cemetery and pray for the dead. Each of us can release one soul a day from Purgatory by entering a cemetery and offering prayers for the dead (one Our Father and one Hail Mary will do). The usual conditions must be fulfilled: communion, confession and Mass. If you cannot satisfy all of the conditions, please remember to visit a grave and pray for the dead so that you can obtain a partial indulgence for the Holy Souls—every little bit helps.

Remember, we pray for them and they pray for us!
